Committee also requested Margie Moser as the banquet announcer, to which MARGIE agreed

NEW BUSINESS

Members discussed the class list and the best use of show schedule

It was suggested doing the VERSATILITY CLASS taking a 30 minute break then doing RANCH

Also suggested completing the COLOR CLASSES and then a thirty minute break before doing VERSATILITY – that would give a chance to set up for the VERSATILITY CLASS

Attention turned to the rules of VERSATILITY and whether or not to use a jump or a pole on the ground. Rules allow for either. Members discussed the pros and cons of each. Most participants leaned heavily towards a ground pole (at most, a raised ground pole) between jump standards

Tammie H made a motion to include a walk/trot division VERSATILITY CLASS.

Julie P seconded the motion all yeas

The w/t division versatility class will be a GSPHC only class, as VERSATILITY is not offered in the APHA W/T division. It will follow the same pattern and rules as the WTL CLASS, except riders will not lope.

THIS CLASS is offered as a BONUS or BENEFIT CLASS. It will accumulate club points ONLY.

Shows –

In OPEN DIVISION exhibitors must show to 6 judges to qualify for year end awards. A variance was discussed but denied. Marissa C made a motion to keep year end requirements at current standards. Julie P seconded the motion.
